



While we hate to do it, we must put a cancellation policy in writing in hopes it never needs discussing but the clarity this provides allows a higher level of trust between us so you can be assured we take your trip very seriously and are going to make every effort to provide you an enjoyable experience on the water.

During peak seasons, we are at times booked solid a couple months in advance for many of our trips. By having us hold a day for you, we turn business down on the assumption we are taking your fishing on this trip on the scheduled date.

When a cancellation occurs, it dramatically affects our staff's earnings and livelihood so we encourage clients to think about this prior to frivolous cancellations.

We must have a credit card on file or have received a check for \$50 per angler for a reservation to be considered booked unless other verbal arrangements have been made with EWA management.

1. Cancellation 2 weeks out -- No Penalty
2. Cancellation 7 days out – Forfeiture of \$50 deposit, applicable towards a reschedule within 6 months of originally scheduled date.
3. Cancellation within 7 days – Forfeiture of 50% of trip cost, applicable towards a reschedule within 6 months of originally scheduled date.
4. Cancellation within 48 hours – Forfeiture of 100% of trip cost or forfeiture of certificate, application towards a future date to be determined by EWA management upon discussion with clients.
5. Day of cancellation by guide due to weather or other circumstances -- No penalty

Guide or instructor may cancel a trip or a class at their discretion for various reasons and do so without penalty. Only the guide or EWA management can make this call.
